200g biscuits –any variety	100g of additional ingredients (e.g. nuts, dried fruit, popcorn, Maltesers etc)
135g butter	2 tbsp golden syrup
200g dark chocolate	icing sugar to dust
100g mini marshmallows	

Method

1. Grease and line an 18cm square tin with baking paper.
2. Cut the biscuits to 20p-sized lumps.
3. In a large saucepan melt the butter, chocolate and golden syrup over a gentle heat, stirring constantly until there are no more lumps of chocolate visible. Remove from the heat and leave to cool.
4. Add the biscuits, marshmallow and additional ingredients to the chocolate mixture until everything is completely covered.
5. Tip the mixture into the lined baking tin and spread it out to the corners. Chill for at least 2 hours then dust with icing sugar and cut into 12 fingers.

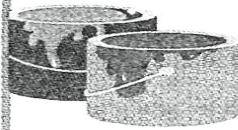

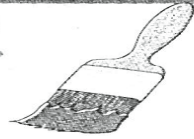
